## COURSE DESCRIPTION

This program is designed for gastroenterologists, surgeons, medical oncologists, radiation oncologists, mid-levels, GI nurses, and other health-care providers who treat patients with GI cancers and who are interested in staying abreast of state-of-the-art clinical practices in GI Cancer. A distinguished and experienced GI oncology faculty panel will share this knowledge through presentation of selected and relevant research findings presented at the major national meeting of the 2012 Gastrointestinal Cancers Symposium.

Topics include the diagnosis and treatment of GI cancers, evidence-based research affecting the practice of GI cancers and new developments in GI cancer diagnosis and multiple treatment modalities.

- Discuss the most relevant research findings presented at the 2012 ASCO/AGA/ASTRO/SSO Gastrointestinal Cancers Symposium
- Define recent developments in the diagnosis and treatment of GI cancers

- Discuss evidence-based research that affects the practice of clinical gastroenterology

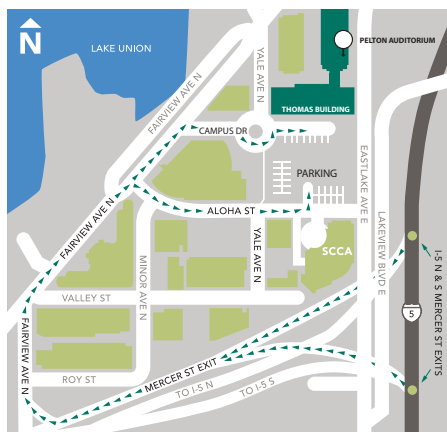
