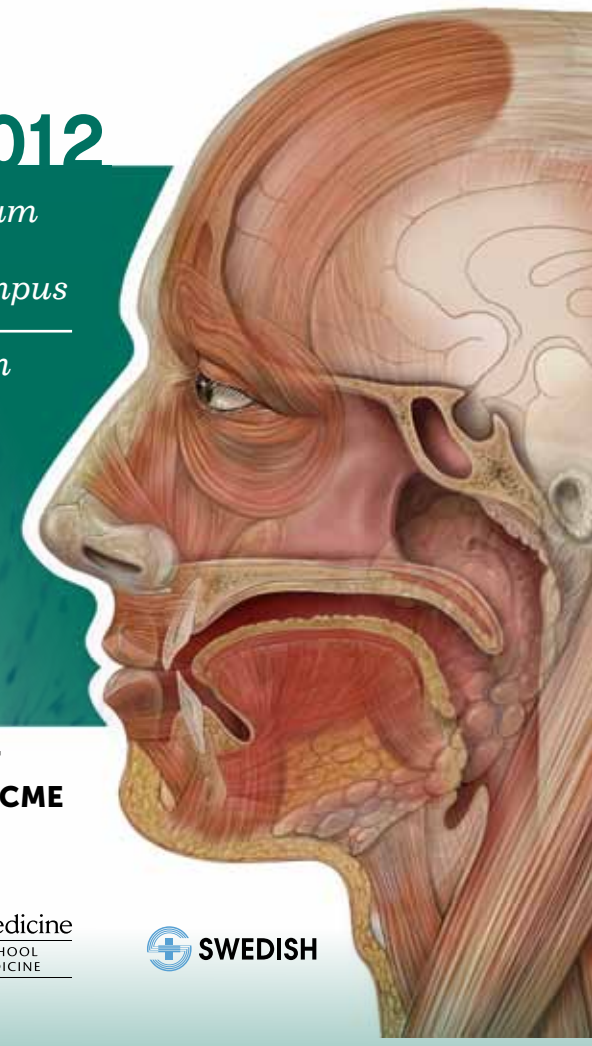

COURSE DESCRIPTION

This symposium has been designed to bring up-to-date scientific information to clinicians involved in the care of patients with head, neck, and thyroid cancer. A multidisciplinary panel of experts will discuss the most recent clinical innovations in their respective fields. These experts will foster discussion in order to expand the knowledge, skills, and performance of the participants.

During each session, attendees will be exposed to new concepts and management protocols indicated in a variety of head, neck, and thyroid cancers. Topics will include minimally invasive laser and robotic surgery, management of side-effects of current chemoradiation protocols, innovation in radiation delivery, and new paradigms in thyroid cancers. The goal of this course is to provide new techniques and protocols to help maximize the care potential for health care providers and their patients.

COURSE OBJECTIVES

Upon completion of this course, participants will be able to:

- Provide an overview of the evaluation and management of head, neck, and thyroid cancers
- Discuss the role of surgery, radiation therapy, chemoradiation, and combined modality therapy in treatment planning
- Understand the clinical uses of novel therapies and approaches in disease management
- Identify new technologies and advancements in the treatment of head, neck, and thyroid cancers
- Discuss current research that may impact clinical management standards in the future

This conference is designed for physicians and allied health professionals who manage patients with head, neck, and thyroid cancers.
