

ADVANCED PRACTICE PROVIDER FELLOWSHIP

in Oncology and Stem Cell Transplant

Qualifications:

- ◆ Applicants must be a current student or graduate of an accredited PA or NP Program
- ◆ Must hold a baccalaureate degree from an accredited college or university; a clinical/health-oriented masters degree is preferred
- ◆ PAs must have passed or be eligible to take the NCCPA Examination
- ◆ Adult, FNP, or Acute Care Nurse Practitioners must have passed or be eligible to take the AANP or ANCC certification examination
- ◆ Must obtain licensure in the state of Washington prior to the program start date
- ◆ Must be eligible for medical staff privileges and faculty appointment



- The Oncology/Stem Cell Transplant Fellowship for Advanced Practice Providers is being offered to Physician Assistants and Nurse Practitioners through the Seattle Cancer Care Alliance and its Alliance partners: Fred Hutchinson Cancer Research Center and the University of Washington.
- This paid one year comprehensive experience will afford the opportunity to participate in one of two tracks: Medical Oncology or Stem Cell Transplant.
 - Benefits include a stipend of \$85k/year, medical and dental benefits, and CME support
 - The program will have two start dates: October 1, 2020 and January 4, 2021. (*Applications are due by March 1st, 2020.*)

Your application packet should include:

- Personal statement of interest which should include a clear indication of why you are interested in this Fellowship and which track you are most interested in pursuing.
- Curriculum Vitae
- Unofficial transcripts from PA or NP program
- 2 reference letters from clinical peer or supervisor
 - If less than 2 years of experience, 1 letter is required from your Program Director
