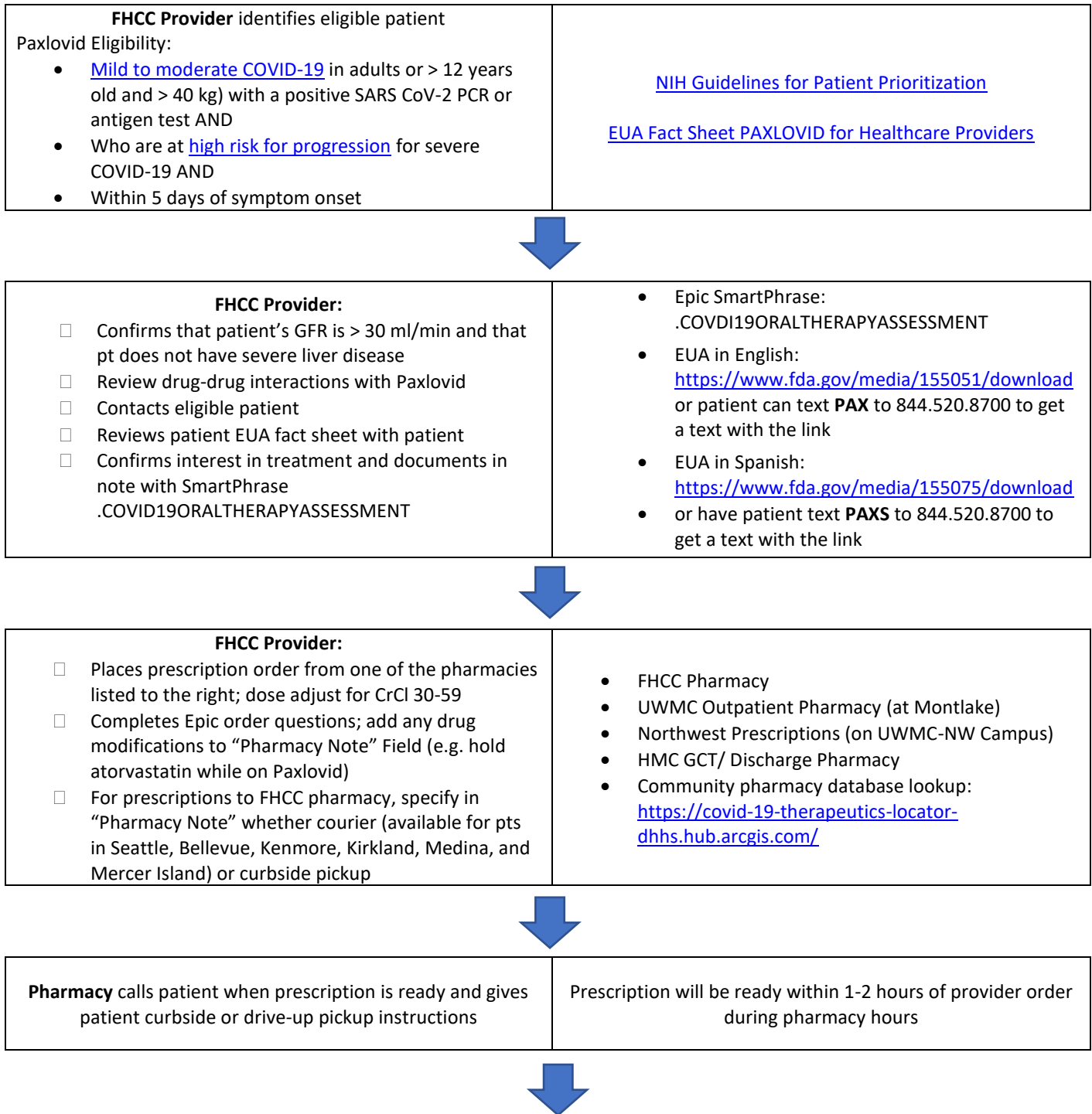


FHCC COVID-19: Paxlovid Oral Antiviral Treatment

*For patients who are not eligible to receive Paxlovid due to drug-drug interactions, they may be eligible to receive other therapies such as monoclonal antibody or molnupiravir. Monoclonal antibody therapy is currently reserved for [NIH Tier 1 and 2 patients](#) and eligibility is determined by Infectious Disease.
