In line with the Governor's approval to resume elective medical appointments, we have resumed screening imaging exams at Seattle Cancer Care Alliance and UW Medicine.

Thank you for trusting us with your care; we take safety seriously and are opening our schedule slowly and intentionally. As an example, we have spaced out appointments so that fewer people will be sitting together in waiting rooms and rearranged our seating to allow appropriate physical distancing. Additionally, our staff are cleaning clinical spaces between patients and all patients and staff wear masks while our facilities.

Our scheduling team is reaching out to schedule exams for patients that have a screening scan due. In the scheduling call, they ask patients if they have any symptoms and/or have had a positive COVID-19 test in the past 14 days. If the patient responds positively to either of those factors, the appointment may be scheduled farther out, or the patient may be routed to our nurse triage team to see if COVID-19 testing is appropriate.

We understand, however, that everyone has different levels of comfort with returning to public and healthcare settings. We are here to support the decision that feels best for you.
