

Financial Assistance Policy

Seattle Cancer Care Alliance (SCCA) provides health care for cancer patients. SCCA offers financial assistance to make hospital-based medical services more affordable for Washington State residents who are at or near the federal poverty level (FPL). You will be given financial assistance based on family need and SCCA's resources.

Application Process

To receive financial assistance, you must complete a financial assistance application. As part of the application process, you will be asked to submit documents showing your financial status. Your access to emergency care will not be delayed or denied because of your inability to pay for services or by health insurance coverage status.
